

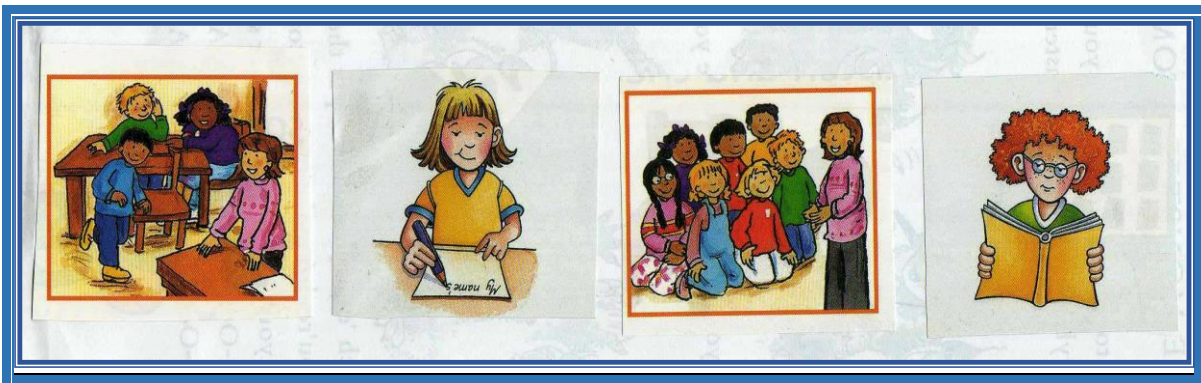
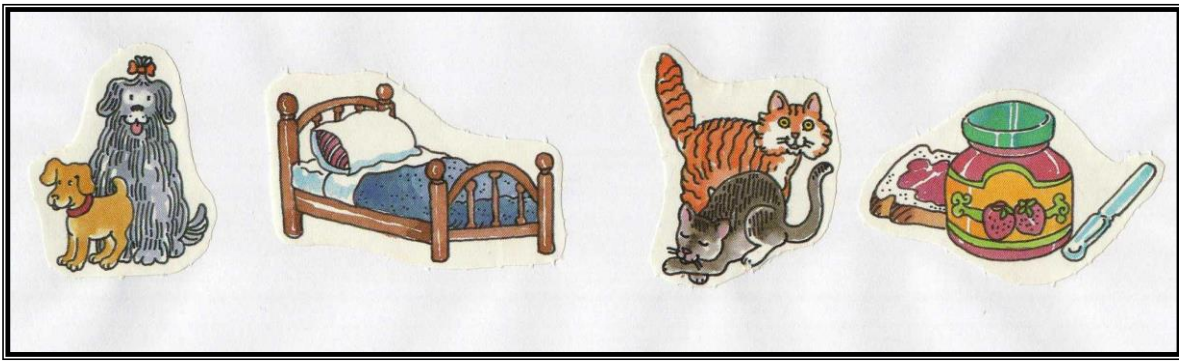
PART D : SPEAKING (15 minutes)

Speaking Task 1 (Warm-up)

Each candidate gives a brief presentation in which she/he introduces herself/himself, describes her/his teaching context and mentions her/his special interests.

Speaking Task 2 (Interaction)

Candidates are required to perform a longer turn based on materials provided by the examining body. They will be asked to choose two pictures and to answer the examiners' questions.



Speaking task 3 (WH- questions)

Here the examiner asks questions related to the candidate's professional life, such as the following:

Could you please tell us about the class you are teaching at the moment?

How many students are there? Are there different nationalities?

What kind of lessons do you prefer teaching?

What kind of games would you use to teach English?

What do you think you are particularly good at?
