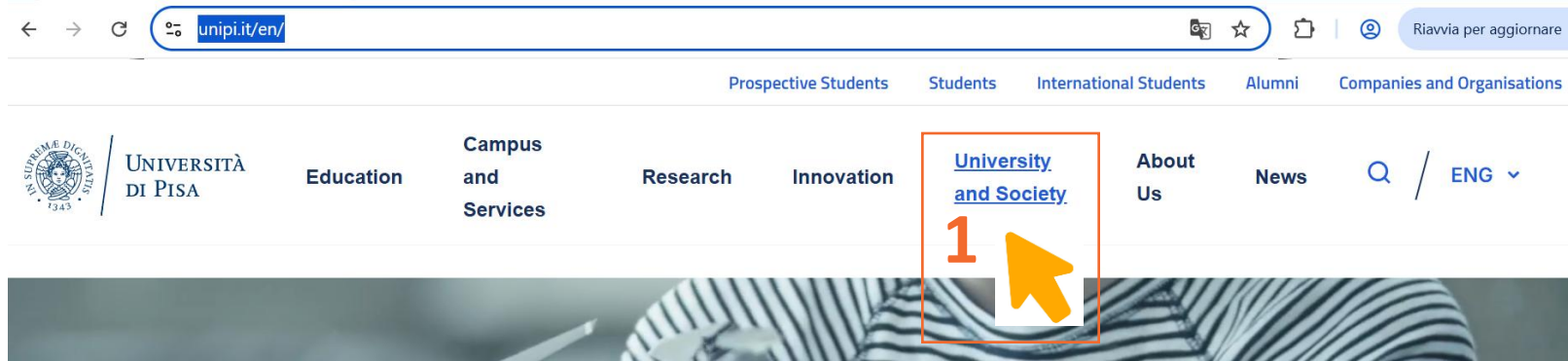

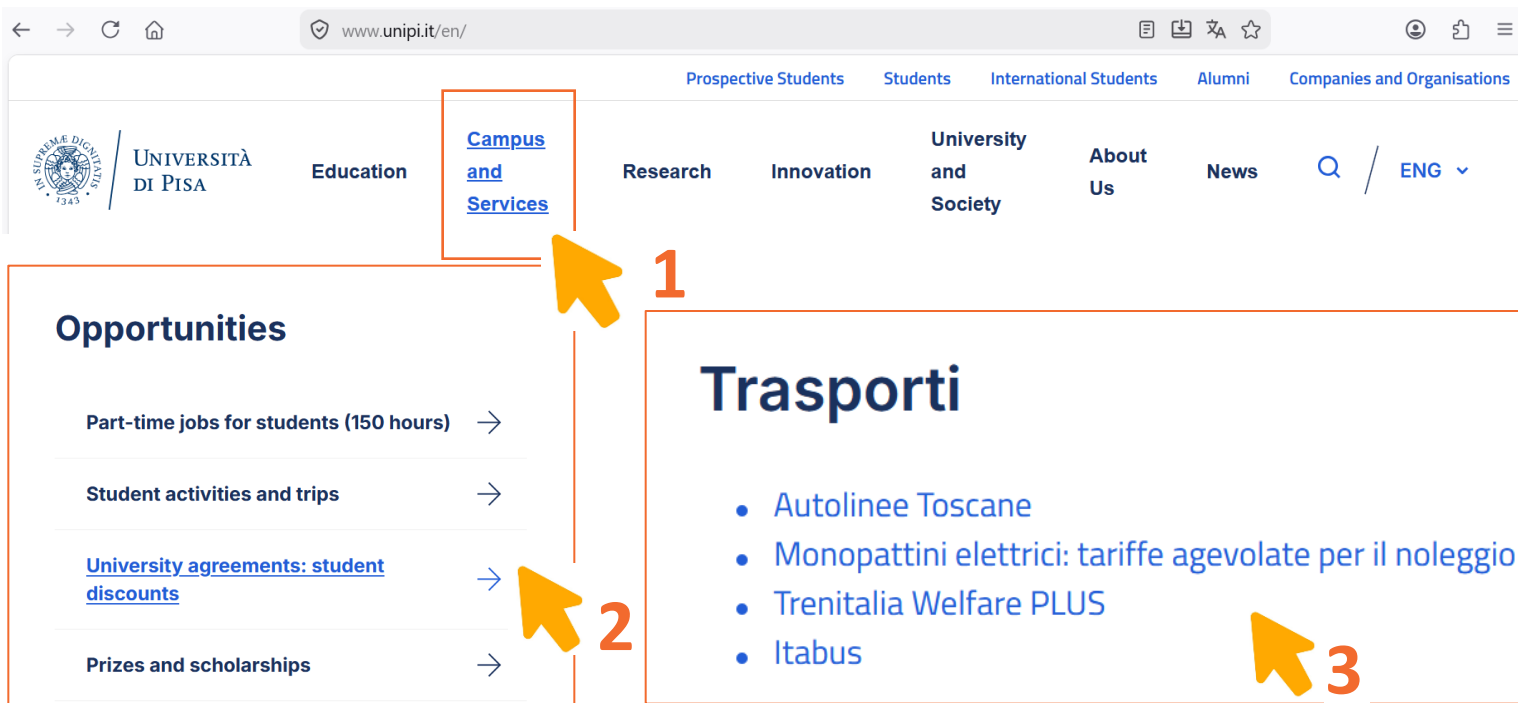

“n0w” project - *nearly Zero waste*:

- A new university waste separation system, supported by an AI-based monitoring system
- Replacement and optimisation of waste bins across the campus
- Elimination of single-use plastic bottles
- Installation of free water dispensers
- Guidelines for sustainable events and graduation celebrations



REACH OUT TO ME FOR:

Bi-monthly meetings to reward the campus locations with the best waste separation performance; collection and sharing of monitoring data; organisation of events involving the distribution of reusable gadgets (water bottles and cups); add or relocate indoor and outdoor waste bins in accordance with the project guidelines.

“Segnali di fumo” project:

- Enforcement of the no-smoking policy,
- Dedicated smoking areas equipped with special ashtrays linked to a cigarette recycling programme that converts cigarette butts into insulation material,
- A pathway towards a completely smoke-free university by 2028.

“Let’s Call Things by Their Name” project:

- Distribution of biodegradable organic cotton sanitary products across the university campus



REACH OUT TO ME FOR:

Designing new smoking areas; Relocating ashtrays and smoking stations; Reporting malfunctions or issues; Identifying locations for no-smoking and other signs; Placement of sanitary product dispensers. Refilling operations and monitoring.
